

## **Residential Usage**

Residential or primary usage toilets do require the same day to day maintenance of all composting toilets. They will, however, fill up faster than a toilet used strictly for weekend or vacation usage. On a residential unit, you will need to take a drawer-full of compost out every 3 weeks, to prevent the drum from over-filling. Please follow the compost removal below for composting toilets that do not have the auto-flow feature:

1. Deposit some compost in the finishing drawer.
2. Leave the compost in the finishing drawer for three weeks.
3. Remove the drawer (after 3 weeks) and dump the contents in a non food producing garden.
4. Replace the finishing drawer in the composting toilet.
5. Pull the drum locker out and turn the handle in an anti-clockwise direction for one turn of the drum (to refill the finishing drawer).
6. Leave the compost in the finishing drawer, in the composting toilet, for three weeks.
7. Repeat steps 2 – 7 every three weeks.

This will prevent the drum from becoming over-full with heavy or residential use if your composting toilet is used as the primary toilet in your residence. If you have any further questions, please contact us.
